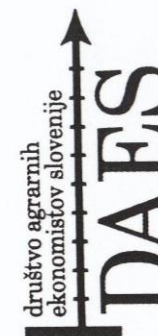

"TOOLS FOR DECISION SUPPORT IN AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT"

Foreword:

One of the basic missions of Society of agricultural economists of Slovenia (DAES) is to establish qualitative and varied public debate about economic and developmental issues of Slovene agriculture, food industry and rural areas in general. Our society's conferences present an important part in fulfilling this mission. As such they are becoming a constant in scientific and professional area in a form of a forum with purpose of exchanging opinions about current economic questions of agri-food chain and development challenges of Slovene rural space. At the same time it represents an opportunity that to present views on current questions and research achievements to wider public. Conferences will be held every three years and in front of us is the sixth DAES conference. Our established thematic concept of the conference remains the same. In the plenary part we will discuss about the central theme with our guest lecturers and round-table, while in the sections research results will be presented and various thematic discussions will be encouraged.

Conference aims and themes:

The central topic of the conference is development and use of tools for decision support in agriculture and rural development. perpetually emerging new business and natural hazards which are caused by existing socio-economic and natural environmental changes, demand constant adaptation of business and development strategies in agriculture and rural development, what is becoming an increasing challenge to be mastered with classical decision making processes. Because of this we would like, with the central theme of the conference, stimulate the development of new and for Slovenian specificities adopted tools for decision support.

Beside the central theme, also discussion on other questions that concern broader agricultural politics, farm management, marketing, food processing and rural development and current problems will be raised.

Argumentation of conference central theme:

The results of the global economic crises in with it connected fall in economic growth and industrial employment also are worsening the situation in agriculture and rural development, as well as financial situations of the states. The second specific group of challenges is connected to effects of climate change, growing price volatility and increase in energy prices. Important aspects are also decrease in biodiversity, increasing consumer's demands for quality and safe food, increasing national self-sufficiency in food production and stimulation of local food supply. The business and natural risks connected with all this facts and ever growing demands for producing safe and quality food are creating more and more complex decision processes, which are difficult to be mastered without corresponding support instruments. With the conference we would like to give a necessary push for development of new and for Slovenian specificities adopted tools for decision support.
